March 21<sup>st</sup> - Stations of the Cross (Families are welcome)

April 4<sup>th</sup> - Saints

April 18<sup>th</sup> - The Bible (Bibles are available for \$5)

May 2<sup>nd</sup> - May Crowning (All families are welcome to Mass at 6pm and then join us in Peaches Hall for a short reception to celebrate the end of this year's program)
